Doodles Pet Care Medical Release Form

This is a required form for all Doodles Pet Care participants receiving services.

First and foremost, the safety and wellbeing of your dog(s) is of the highest importance. Ensuring that your dog(s) remains safe and well cared for is our first responsibility and as such, we take it very seriously. We do our best to have our dog(s) parents screen for pre-existing health conditions but some factors may be beyond our control. In the event that a medical emergency arises while your dog(s) is at our location or participating in a service that we provide, it is imperative that we are immediately able to get them the medical treatment that they require at the closest available facility. We will call ahead to the veterinary offices in the closest proximity geographically to us to insure they can handle the emergency present. Your pet will be taken to the closest available facility for treatment and you will be notified. We will notify the owner after we have secured a medical treatment center for the dog to avoid delays that may be caused by emotion on the part of the owner. Our goal is to get your dog the medical attention they require as quickly as possible. For this reason, all of our dog parents are required to sign this form.

By signing below, I understand that in the event of a medical emergency Doodles Pet Care, at its sole discretion deems to need the immediate attention of a licensed veterinarian, I authorize Doodles Pet Care to seek medical attention at the closest available veterinary facility. I further agree that I am financially responsible for any and all treatment that my dog receives as a result of a medical emergency while attending services provided by Doodles Pet Care.

Doodles Pet Care Contract

This is a Contract between Doodles pet Care (hereinafter called "kennel") and the pet owner as identified by the signature below (hereinafter called "owner"). This contract is in effect any time the pet is boarded at Doodles Pet Care.

- Dog required vaccines (distemper/Parvo, rabies, and Bordetella) are the responsibility of the owner and are kept up to date. Proof of vaccines will be provided to the Kennel whenever vaccines are updated. Owner also is required to have an active flea/tick treatment plan in place.
- Owner agrees to pay the rate for boarding in effect on the date the pet is checked into the Kennel (as posted in reception area, and as indicated as per phone conversation or rates posted).
- Owner further agrees to pay all costs and charges for special services requested, and all veterinary costs for the pet during the time the pet is in the care of the Kennel.
- Owner further agrees that the pet shall not leave the Kennel until all charges are paid in full to the Kennel by the Owner.
- By signing this Contract and leaving your pet with the Kennel, the Owner certifies to the accuracy of all information provided about the pet within their Pet Profile.
- Kennel shall exercise reasonable care for the pet delivered, by the Owner to the Kennel for boarding. It is expressly agreed by the Owner and Kennel that the Kennel's liability shall in no event exceed the lesser of the current chattel value of a pet of the same species or the sum of \$200.00 per animal boarded. The Owner further agrees to be solely responsible for any and all acts or behaviors of said pet while it is in the care of the Kennel.
- The Owner specifically represents that he or she is the sole owner of the pet and is free and clear of all liens and encumbrances.
- The Owner specifically represents to Kennel that the pet has not been exposed to rabies or Distemper within a thirty (30) day period prior to boarding.
- All charges incurred by the Owner shall be payable upon pick-up of pet. The Kennel shall have, and is hereby granted, a lien on the pet for any and all unpaid charges resulting from boarding said pet at the Kennel. The owner hereby agrees that in the event the boarding charges are not paid when due in accordance with the contract, the Kennel may exercise its lien rights upon ten (10) days written notice given by the Kennel to the Owner by certified mail to address shown on contract. The Kennel may dispose of pet for any and all unpaid charges, at private or public sale, or to local humane society, in the sole discretion of the Kennel and the Owner specifically waives all statutory or legal rights to the contrary. If such sale shall not secure a price adequate to pay such costs of board and other charges delinquent, plus cost of sale, then the Owner shall be liable to the Kennel for the difference. All monies realized by the Kennel at such sale, over and above the charges due and costs of sale, shall be paid by the Kennel to the Owner.
- If the pet becomes ill, or if the state of the animal's health otherwise requires professional attention, the Kennel, in its sole discretion, may engage the services of a veterinarian or administer medicine or give other requisite attention to the animal, and the expenses thereof shall be paid by the Owner.
- This Contract contains the entire agreement between the Owner and the Kennel. All terms and conditions of this Contract shall be binding on the heirs, administrators, personal representatives and assigns of the Owner and the Kennel.
- Any controversy of claim arising out of or relating to this contract, or the breach thereof, or as the result of any claim or controversy involving the alleged negligence by any party to this contract, shall be settled by arbitration in accordance with the rules of the American Arbitration Association, and judgment upon the award rendering by an arbitrator may be entered in any Court having jurisdiction thereof. The arbitrator shall, as part of his/her award, determine an award to the prevailing party of the costs of such arbitration and reasonable attorneys' fees of the prevailing party.
- If reservations are made and cancelled more than three times, a 50% non-refundable deposit will be required for additional reservations.
